CINCO REGIONAL SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT

The Board of Directors of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 81 of Harris County, Texas, will hold a special meeting on Thursday, May 19, 2022, at 6:00 p.m., at 805 Hidden Canyon, Katy, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

2. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including payment of the bills and review of investment of Cinco Plant funds.
3. Cinco Plant operations, discharge, repairs and maintenance, including update on replacement of mixer pump no. 2 and security camera equipment upgrades.
4. Receive report of Engineer, including:
 - a. Capital Improvement Plan;
 - b. pay estimates, change orders, substantial completion and final acceptance for Phase 4 rehabilitation of main influent trunkline;
 - c. approve plans and specifications and authorize advertisement for bids for trunk line sanitary sewer rehabilitation, Phases 5 and 7;
 - d. authorize design for trunk line manhole rehabilitation, Phases 5 and 7;
 - e. Cinco Municipal Utility District No. 1 effluent reuse system, including discuss reclaimed water permit application; and
 - f. wastewater discharge permit renewal application.
5. Operation, repair, maintenance, and rental of Administrative Office and employment matters.
