  - c. reclaimed water facility matters, including Second Amendment to Reclaimed Water Agreement with Cinco Municipal Utility District No. 1 and Second Supplemental to Letter Agreement.
5. Discuss Harris County request for use of the administrative building for the July primary run-off elections and authorize appropriate action.
6. Discuss potential purchase of park benches for Mason Creek hike and bike trail extension.
7. Employment matters, including, if appropriate, convene in Executive Session pursuant to Section 551.074, Texas Government Code, to deliberate the appointment, employment, evaluation, reassignment, duties, discipline, or dismissal of a public officer or employee.
8. Reconvene in Open Session and authorize appropriate action regarding the appointment, employment, evaluation, reassignment, duties, discipline, or dismissal of a public officer or employee.
