#### CINCO REGIONAL SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT

  - c. emergency repairs to sanitary sewer manhole;
  - d. manhole rehabilitation, including proposed phasing plan;
  - e. emergency force main replacement;
  - f. update on security camera wiring installation; and
